



#### ACCOMPLISHMENTS

- The 155 incoming master's students are from 29 U.S. states and 31 countries; 40 percent are international.
- Fifty-five percent of 22 admitted doctoral students are international; 59 percent are male, and 41 percent are female.
- Faculty and staff diversity has increased over the last three years.
- YSE held its first **Diversity Day** for incoming students; **84** students participated.
