ACCOMPLISHMENTS

- In 2023, we welcomed seven New Haven Promise Scholars for internships in science, administration, and at the Yale School of Nursing, increasing the number of campus units participating in the program by over 40 percent.
- The West Campus Pathways to Science Festival 2023 brought over 160 local area middle- and high-school students to Campus for a full day of hands-on science events.
